<u>Overview</u>

What is Data Mining?

- Generic Term A process used by Governments,
 Organisations and Companies to turn raw data into useful information.
- Data Mining relies on sources of information.
 - What does your organisation know?
 - What does your organisation NOT know?



Suspicious Bidding Patterns

<u>Identification Issues / Opportunities</u>

- What is 'Suspicious'?
 - May not be apparent in current bidding process.
- Internal records re bidding companies.
 - Intelligence / Analysis Resource.
 - Investigation Resource.
- May not be apparent in Single Organisation data.
- Government Department records.
- Foreign Government records.
 - Regional Information Sharing initiatives.



Suspicious Bidding Patterns

Know Your Staff

- What does your organisation know about your staff?
- What does it NOT know?
- Statutory Asset Declarations?
- Vetting Procedures?
 - Family relationships: Parents, Children, Siblings, etc.
- Professional Standards Intelligence Units?
 - Co-Worker relationships: Boss, Supervisor, Staff.



Suspicious Bidding Patterns

Potential Corruption Indicators

- Expenditure Profile > Income Profile.
- Assets not compatible with known income.
 - Property Ownership
 - Motor Vehicles
 - Jewellery
 - Clothing
 - Collectibles
 - Boats
 - Holidays
 - Schooling



Identifying Relationships

- The existence of a relationship is not necessarily suspicious.
 - Companies often have working relationships with others.
 - Staff often have relatives working in Industry.
- Have the companies declared the relationship when bidding for a contract?
- Has the member of Staff declared the relationship if over-seeing the procurement process?
- The identification of a relationship can be the first indicator of Corruption or Collusion.



- Organisation/Government internal records.
- Partner Organisation/Government records.
- Official Company registers / records.
- Official Financial or Banking records.
 - Companies and their Directors/Staff.
 - Your Staff.

 - Databases for Background & Asset checks.
 - Subscription services for Public & Court records.
 - Social / Business Networks
 - Investigative Bloggers.
 - Anti-Corruption NGO reporting.
 - Transparency International
 - UNODC, Interpol, StAR






